

# Missions Ministry

2022 First Quarter Highlights from Family Promise are as follows:

- In the first three months of 2022, staff at Family Promise have been busy helping a total of 65 households which consisted of 81 adults and 85 children. This includes, all programs: Emergency Shelter, Rapid Re-Housing, and Homeless Prevention
  - \$57,508 was provided in rent assistance
  - Our network congregations provided 710 meals
  - Our shelter program provided 983 nights of shelter
- On January, 18th New Fortune Asian Cuisine in Cedarburg held a fundraiser for Family Promise. Thank you to all that participated as well as the staff and owners!
- We were named Charity of the month for the Fox Bros Piggly Wiggly.
   What an honor and thank you so much for your contributions to our mission!
- We have a new addition to our Family Promise network of churches!
  - Welcome, Grand Avenue United Methodist Church to our congregational network. With your help, we will be able to continue to rebuild lives with compassion and make sure that our families have access to healthy meals regardless of circumstance.




