Power will be turned off to the shed. The church will continue to maintain the care (plowing, black top) of the shared driveway. Will tithe 10% of sale, need to decide how much will go to general fund and/or maintenance trust fund.

Commission Agreement/Policy: Talk to Carrie about potential of commission opportunities for new renters/users of church building.

1 year rental contract = 1st month's rent, daily event = 20% of facility fee. Heather will work on this policy.

Pastor will remain in Pulpit Supply Position for now.

Oscar will be baptized in April.

Carrie's PTO policy has been updated: "Hi Carrie, We thank you for all your contributions to our church and appreciate all you do to assist in our day-to-day activities as well as helping to coordinate our Sunday services. Regarding the paid time off (PTO) policy for 2023, it was agreed upon that we would extend 3 weeks of PTO. PTO will be accrued on a monthly basis based on the below data:

20 hours worked per week

60 total PTO hours to be accrued (20 hours per week and 3 weeks of PTO)

12 month calendar

5 hours of accrued PTO per month

As all PTO hours are accrued at months end, we can allow the December "to be accrued" hours to be used in the month of December. Any accrued and unused PTO will be included on year-end paycheck or in an event that results in final paycheck prior to year-end. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.
