FAREWELL TO PASTOR SUSAN




On Sunday, July 24th we held a special service and farewell luncheon for Pastor Susan Drake. We wish her the best! Below is the closing prayer from the service:


AUGUST MISSION: OCWM OUR CHURCH'S WIDER MISSION
