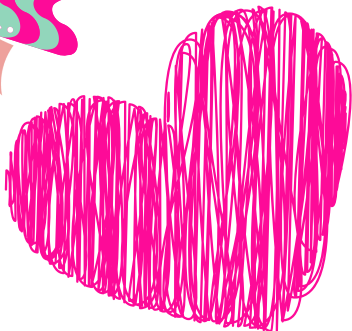

Worship: Sue and Joan are working on Lent decorations. Holy Week service information to come: 6:00 on Ash Wednesday and Maundy Thursday. There is no Good Friday service. Looking to order new banners for the sanctuary for the Easter season, the color is white and we don't have any white. Motion made by Kait W. to spend up to \$5000.00 for new Easter season banners from Gaspard, second by Christian L. Motion passed. Sue will look into if these can be made and arrive in time, if not we will push off for next year.

Building & Grounds: 1 garbage disposal not working in kitchen, can use the other one for now.

Caring: No report, the prayer list went out.

Missions: Kathy T. resigned as committee chair. Looking for someone to take over as committee chair. We are running the 2022 mission schedule again this year.

Old Business:

Parsonage: Accepted offer on the parsonage, had over 30 showings and 8 offers. Working on the shared driveway agreement, surveyor came out.

New Business:

Pastoral Profile: One person has applied.

Amendments to Carrie's Paid Time Off Policy: Christian L. will make changes to original. Pastor Laura's position will move from a pulpit supply position to Designated Interim position, continuing her ten hours a week.

Parsonage update: Accepted offer of 270,000. The home inspection has been completed and closing is expected in about 45 days if all goes as expected, around the end of March. The shed will be included in the sale of the parsonage. The labyrinth will be deconstructed and returned to the eagle scout who built it and A Place to Be. Surveyor will be out to redo the lot lines and create the shared driveway agreement. The realtor will get 6% fees and we would like to tithe 10% of net sales price to missions. Please think about what missions you would like to see us support whether it be local or global. We will need to decide how to split the rest of the profits between the general fund and the maintenance trust fund.

Church Profile update: We have received a profile for the Pastor position and council members will be setting up a zoom meeting. If you would like to join please let Heather R. know.

Pastor Laura met with the council on February 14th, 2023 and will be with us for the time to come, she will be moving into an interim position.

Missions Committee Update: Looking for a new chairperson, the committee may have to disband if they can't find a new chairperson.

Sue S. and Joan B. have been looking into new banners for the Easter season for the Sanctuary in 2024, looking to fundraise for the new banners.

Motion to adjourn by Ron N., second by Sandy D. Motion passed.
