April 10, 2018 Council Meeting Notes

Present: Mark Gierach, Michelle Fuentes, Heather Rogge, Joan Brecke, Kaitlyn Beck, Wally Quade, Sue Sarver, Pastor Michelle

President Gierach called meeting to order at 6:32pm. Pastor Michelle opened with prayer.

March Council Minutes: Pastor Michelle motioned to accept as submitted. 2nd Brecke. Passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: M. Fuentes presented March financials. Motion Rogge, second Beck to accept. Passed unanimously. We budgeted \$750 for the UCC. Conference. It will be closer to \$900. We need to adjust for 2019 budget. Need to look at Mike Chapel's pay for the summer. Pastor Michelle and Gierach will speak with him.

Pastor's Report – Please see attached report (stop in the church office for a copy). Work is being done on installation. Pastor Michelle will be a delegate at General Synod 2019.

Committees

Faith Formation – There will be a joint VBS meeting this month. There is a youth group meeting as well. Family Fun Night on April 13.

Stewardship – No report.

Worship –Looking at music options when Mike Chapel is not available. Worship services at 10am year round. Consider faith formation year-round as well. There will be a music committee. Pastor will select one hymn to match lectionary and committee to chose the 2 other songs. Committee to be Gail, Mike, Mark and Paul. Cost for Batzner Pest Control for building split 50/50 with the food pantry will be explored. Communion changeover to grape juice only was discussed and rejected.

Building & Grounds – Dan Race will be contracted to handle lawn care for 2018. Mailbox will be installed for Pastor Michelle once frost is out of the ground. A work day will be scheduled. The tree next to the sign might have to be removed because of the tree sap. Parking lot – need to firm up the date for starting this in connection with the Village. Curtain or blind needs to be added to one door in parsonage. Ants in parsonage. Water faucet in parsonage needs to be updated.

Caring – All visitor cards updated and in pews. Soup fundraiser - \$702 profit to be used for the joint youth minister. Prayer chain is active.

Missions – Looking to rejuvenate committee. Looking at human trafficking and addiction missions.

150th – Celebration continues.

Old Business

• Visioning Meeting – May 5, 9-11am. Breakfast included (Wally Quade, Heather Rogge, Kaitlyn Beck and Henry Rogge are excused due to prior commitments).

• Safe Sanctuary policies, active shooter policies, medical policies. Need to review these policies. Assigned to Faith Formation committee to steer. A. Fuentes and Pastor Michelle volunteered to sit on committee too. Limit 5. Pastor Michelle will announce from pulpit Sunday. Faith Formation will collect documents from the Association.

New Business

• Pastor Relations Committee. 3 selections from the pastor and 3 from the council. Would like to get it going by the end of August. Group would meet quarterly.

• Inactive list – need to look at list annually or every other year.

• Piano player for weeks when Mike Chapel is not available. Suggestion to post on Indeed and contact Concordia Music Department to see if they have any students interested in playing. Need to work out costs and where it will funded from the budget.

• Carrie cannot open safe with combination. She can open it with a key. Carrie will be asked to find a safe and add purchase price to budget for 2019.

• Weddings - look at ways to market our location for weddings

Worship committee brought to the council to offer just grape juice for communion. This would eliminate white grape juice and wine; and would accommodate everyone except the gluten free restrictions would have to


have a separate location. Church council has voted to continue to offer wine and white grape juice for communion.



Unfinished Business

- Lawn maintenance for both the Church and the Parsonage will be done by Dan Race. There will be two applications of Weed and Feed.
- The Parking Lot will be resurfaced by Boehlke's. We need to repair the mounds in the Parking Lot and remove overgrown shrub in west side mound. The village plans to complete the new pavilion by Memorial Day. We will schedule work as soon as possible after completion of the pavilion.
- Need to install a new mailbox for the Parsonage; materials are all here.
- Wally is working on getting quotes to modify trash enclosure to accommodate a two yard dumpster. We will save \$40.00 a month with the dumpster as opposed to adding a third container.
- The Spring Cleanup is scheduled for April 28th from 9:00AM until 1:00PM.
- The carpeting needs to be cleaned. We have the machine but will need volunteers to assist (moving furniture, emptying water, etc.). It will be scheduled when the weather improves.
- Pastor Michelle has asked to have a ceiling fan installed in the master bedroom. She will
 purchase the fan; we need to determine if the infrastructure exists to mount the fan or if we
 need to add it.
- There is a broken pane in a basement window in the Parsonage that needs to be repaired.
- We are looking into the cost for putting a fence on the north side of the Parsonage lot.

To give to this mission, just look for specially marked "Strengthen the Church" envelopes in the pews on Sundays during the month of May.


