to Evansville, Indiana to be with Pastor Georgia.


Ultimately I would love to remain in Wisconsin. In spite of being a die hard Southerner, I really like Wisconsin and the winters don't bother me.


CARD MINISTRY HELP NEEDED

Tuesday, November 19 @ 6:00 - Detective Lt. DeMaine Milbach of Ozaukee County Sheriffs Office will be giving a presentation - highlighting two success stories in the past year where The Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office has been successful in combatting Human/Sex Trafficking.

Tuesday, November 19

Lt. DeMaine Milbach, PMC is the Detective Lieutenant of the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office and supervises all of the detectives assigned to the Sheriff's Office as well as the intra-county Officers and Deputies assigned to the Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Task Force. He is the Coordinator for the Ozaukee County Child Abduction Response Team (CART). Detective Lt. Milbach will be highlighting two success stories in the past year where the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Office has been successful in combatting Human/Sex Trafficking. These examples will show the successful partnership between the community, Advocate groups, the Department of Human Services, Law Enforcement, and the Milwaukee County Human Trafficking Task Force. In 2016 Lt. Milbach retired from the United States Air Force after serving 29 years both in an active duty and reserve capacity.


